Stewardship Possibilities



As people of God at Saint James, we are blessed with exceptional gifts every day: Your participation — in prayer & worship, faith formation, community outreach, music & the arts — is a gift to God, our neighbors, and the wider world. Think broadly & expansively of stewardship as the *intentional* use of our time, talents, and treasure, both within & beyond the walls of the church, in gratitude for all that God has given.

Below is a sampling of possible aims/commitments you might contemplate as you complete your 2025 Pledge Card. It is not a complete list but is intended to give you some ideas to get you started!

Cathedral Pledge

- Both the Hebrew and Christian scriptures contain a clear understanding that the appropriate response to God's generosity from God's people is a *tithe*, meaning 10% of income.
- A Pledge is an *estimate* of giving it may be changed if your financial circumstances change.
- *Making* a Pledge allows you to make intentional decisions about your finances: when you plan ahead, you make conscious choices about using your money in ways that reflect your faith and values.
- *Receiving* your Pledge allows the Cathedral's governing board (called the Cathedral Chapter) to plan wise support of the mission & ministry to which God has called us: the Cathedral budget is based on the total amount pledged; while plate offerings are always appreciated, your Pledge lets the Cathedral plan more accurately for the work & ministry we can accomplish.

Stewarding our prayer life

- say grace at each meal
- start/end each day giving thanks to God for three things
 - create a *touchstone prayer*: a short prayer you say every time you do a regular action; e.g.
 - every time you walk in your front door: "Thank you God for my family."
 - while brushing your teeth: "Thank you God for my physical health."
- set aside 10 minutes x 3–4 times per week for quiet, contemplative prayer
- pray all / some portion of the Daily Office (p. 37ff) or Daily Devotion for Individuals & Families (p. 137ff) provided in the *Book of Common Prayer* (1979)
- plan to worship in person at church ___ times a month (more than you currently do in a typical month)
 O Holy Eucharist: Sundays at 8am Spoken 9am Family I I am Choral
- worship & pray communally in a Cathedral service outside of Sunday mornings:
 - Morning Prayer: 9am weekdays on Zoom (<u>us02web.zoom.us/j/89796765807</u>)
 - Noonday Eucharist: 12:10pm weekdays
 - Chorister Evensong: 5:45pm Wednesdays (September-June)
 - Compline: 7:30pm Wednesdays
 - Choral Evensong: 4pm first Sundays (October–June)
